

TOUCH

- 6 weeks
 - Baby is 1-inch long
 - Slender nerve fiber snake out to new parts of your body
 - Touch begins
 - Millions of neurons are forming to set up a communication network
 - Fingers start to form
 - Nerve fibers begin to bond
- 8 weeks
 - Fingers begin to sculpt and become defined
 - Touch travels to different parts of your body
- 6 months
 - Fingerprints fully formed
 - Start growing hair follicles and sweat glands
 - Covered in fine, downy hair
 - Delicate layer of skin
- 35 weeks
 - Eyelashes start to develop
 - Flow of amniotic fluid travels to end of hair
 - The baby develops a palm-grasp reflex (babies will grasp everything that touches their hands)
- 8 months
 - Ready to experience a new world

SMELL

- One of the first senses to develop
- Nerve connects your tiny nose to tiny brain and links sense of smell directly to your core of consciousness permeating your emotions
- Guides memories
- 28 weeks
 - Detect range of flavors, that reach you from your mother's bloodstream of amniotic fluid such as
 - Smell same things as mother
 - Smells irritate hairs in nose, causing baby to sneeze

TASTE

- 50 days from conception
 - Sucking your thumb
- 16 weeks
 - You receive taste from Mother's blood stream and amniotic fluid
- 21 weeks
 - Swallow several ounces of fluid a day
 - Begin to taste what mother is eating
- 25 week
 - Develop most sensitive taste: bitterness
- 28 weeks
 - Taste a range of flavors

HEARING

- 8 weeks
 - Your hearing starts and blood starts flowing through the baby's body
 - Cavities will become the coils of your ears
- 35 weeks
 - You start to hear your mother's voice/language and recognize it
 - Can soothe a baby and slows their heart rate
 - Your body reacts to the music you like
- A Few Weeks Before Birth
 - You develop a memory of music

SIGHT

- 8 weeks
 - Sight begins
 - Eye is made of a delicate web of tissue
 - Biological cocktail of DNA
 - Optical nerves grow
- 15 weeks
 - Size of an apple
 - Eyes move side to side
 - Eyelids cannot open
- 25 weeks
 - Eyelids open
 - Retinas grow, making vision more precise
 - Can tell difference between the colors: blue, green & red
- 35 weeks
 - Eyes are formed
 - Heart rate quickens
 - Can express a variety of feelings
